Liveable Streets

- Project started last April
- Traffic volumes in Bow really high
- A12 to City road closure
- Market: Every day all the time pedestrians in the area
- Reduce rat runs
- Making sure drop kerbs are where they should be
- Road furniture in the right place
- Pedestrianize Roman Road

LV actives members feedback

- Bus gate issues for disabled resident access
- De clutter - get rid / regulate use of shop's using pavement signs and related street furniture
- Roman road should be paved more.
- Seating an issue, look at seating solutions in Lambeth for ideas (static individual seats)
- Toilets for disabled people, LS will raise the issues with Tower Hamlets Council
- Ability Bow query – spoke with them about Blue badge exemption
